SPEAKERS

Dr. Annette Henry is Head of Language & Literacy Education at UBC with broad expertise in language and literacy education and the sociology of education.

Dr. Patsy Duff is Co-Director of UBC's Centre for Research in Chinese Language and Literacy Education and Professor of Language & Literacy Education (TESL and Modern Language Education).

Dr. Myriam Met is an independent consultant (retired from the National Foreign Language Center at the University of Maryland). She has published and consulted widely on k-12 immersion, bilingual, content-based and foreign/world & English language teaching programs, as well as teacher education.

Dr. Keiko Koda is Professor of Modern Languages and Second Language Acquisition at Carnegie Mellon University in Pittsburgh. She is internationally recognized for her research and publications on cross-linguistic literacy (reading).

Dr. Luyi Lien is Academic Director of Yinghua Academy in Minnesota, a Mandarin immersion charter school. She has expertise in Mandarin program development, curriculum, and pedagogy.

Dr. Duanduan Li is Co-Director of CRCLLE and Director of the UBC Chinese Language Program. Her specialization is Chinese applied linguistics, Chinese language teaching, and resources for Chinese heritage and non-heritage learners.

Dr. Ross King is Head of Asian Studies at UBC and Professor of Korean Language/Linguistics. He is interested in language ideologies and Chinese, Japanese, and Korean language education, programs, research, and use.

Dr. Ryuko Kubota is Professor of Language & Literacy Education at UBC, who has expertise in English and East Asian language education and teacher education.

Dr. Monique Bournot-Trites is President of the Canadian Association of Applied Linguistics and Associate Professor of Language & Literacy Education at UBC. Her specialization is French immersion (research, teaching, teacher education, and assessment).
